Role description: To lead the delivery of coaching and sport science provision of the IFA. To lead the management of Loughborough Futsal Club first and development teams. To line manage the coaching and sport science staff of the IFA, and coordinate Loughborough Students Futsal Club coaches.

Duties and responsibilities:

- To design the coaching programme for the International Futsal Academy and the two teams in the FA Futsal National Leagues.
- To lead the teams on the FA Futsal National Leagues, ensuring all IFA and team sessions and games are appropriately covered even in the event of clashes.
- To decide the composition of IFA and Loughborough Futsal Club teams and squads
- To aspire to achieve an environment of high performance to maximise development opportunities for players and staff
- To enhance the playing/student experience of the Academy participants, contributing as well to their personal, academic and playing development
- To plan, deliver and review Super League and Development teams, and IFA sessions.
- To supervise the planning, delivery and review of sessions by other members of the coaching and sport science staff.
- To support IFA and Loughborough Students Coaches in their positions and their professional development
- To supervise coaching and sport science delivery to maintain coherence throughout the Academy's programme
- To agree and coordinate teams' composition with relevant stakeholders of Loughborough Students Futsal Club and to coordinate with Loughborough Students Futsal Club staff the appropriate provisions for the Super League and Development teams.
- To ensure all IFA and Super League sessions and games are appropriately covered, keeping appropriate record of planned and conducted sessions by any member of staff

- To line manage the IFA staff designated by the Academy Director.
- To provide pastoral support to players
- To ensure kit and equipment are appropriately taken care of by the relevant staff
- To attend staff meetings
